What is Literacy Nassau's Next Chapter Book Club?

How does it work?

Book club members meet weekly for one hour at local bookstores, libraries, coffee shops and cafés to read and discuss a book of their choosing.

Who can participate?

Anyone can participate, regardless of their reading or ability level.

Who leads the book clubs?

Trained volunteers facilitate each group by assisting those who may struggle with reading, while encouraging participation and community.
